

Convention Banquet features St. Peter's Puppeteers

Following the banquet meal, the Rev. Mary Garner and some members of the children's troupe of the St. Peter's (Salisbury) Fifth Sunday Players will present a follow-up to the Environmental Committee's workshop. The short original production has been written and costumed by the children, and is based on concepts that were presented today from the book, *7 Simple Steps to Green Your Church*. The children and youth of St. Peter's have the opportunity to participate in a variety of sacred puppetry and creative dramatic events. St. Peter's Puppeteers have performed for community service events, Cafe Nites, and Sunday morning Scripture Moments during the services. The scripts and costuming of the puppets are created by the children and youth during mini-workshops. St. Peter's Fifth Sunday Players have presented programs for Christmas, Epiphany, and as a fundraiser for the Children's Home Foundation. The Players were trained during an eight-week Sacred Drama workshop during which they wrote, produced, and presented an original musical entitled, "The Weeping 'Ghost.'" All of the performers also had the opportunity to attend the Sacred Story-telling Workshop that took place at St. Alban's (Salisbury) last fall.
