

Licensed Ministries Training in Easton

For 2010, the Diocese is again offering an autumn training program for three licensed ministries (*Eucharistic Ministers*, *Eucharistic Visitors*, and *Worship Leaders*) and for *Lectors*, who are not required to have a license, but who can obtain a certificate by attending a one-day session (offered on both Day 1 and Day 3). Sponsored by the Commission on Ministry, all training sessions will take place on Saturdays in Easton at Trinity Cathedral's Miller Hall. The Commission will provide lunch on all three days.

Day 1: Saturday, September 25, 9 a.m.-4 p.m. - training for *all* ministries (including a complete session for *Lectors*).

Day 2: Saturday, October 16, 9 a.m.-12 noon - training for *Eucharistic Ministers* and *Eucharistic Visitors*.

Day 3: Saturday, November 20, 9 a.m.-4 p.m. - training for *Worship Leaders*, *Eucharistic Visitors*, and *Lectors* (complete session).

Participants will only be able to train for one ministry at a time, with the exception of *Eucharistic Visitor* and *Eucharistic Minister*. Laity currently holding diocesan ministry licenses will not be required to attend the training, but the Diocese strongly encourages them to do so.
